

AWARDS PRESENTATION DISTRICT CONVENTION

SPIRIT OF SERVICE AWARD

Past Governor Don Loiselle established the « Spirit of Service » Award to recognize a Kiwanian for enthusiastic dedication and outstanding service to the District. The winner n engraved personal plaque.

This Award should be changed to: Kiwanian of The Year Award, be a hi-light of the Awards for a “District Member Only” and be selected by the then current Governor.

KIWANIS FOUNDATION OF CANADA AWARD

The Kiwanis Foundation of Canada presents this award to a Kiwanian or non-Kiwanian recommended by the Host Club of the District Convention to recognize their Outstanding Community Service. The winner receives a Mel Osborne Medal.

RAY ALLEN MEMORIAL AWARD

This trophy is provided by the Past Lieutenant-Governor’s Committee to recognize a Past Lieutenant-Governor who continues to contribute and participate in Club and Division activities. The winner receives a personal plaque.

CITATION LIEUTENANT GOVERNORS

Kiwanis International determines the criteria for this award. Recommendations are made by the Governor to Kiwanis International. The winners receive a Citation.

AWARD OF EXCELLENCE

The Award of Excellence was established by Past Governor Charles D. Forsyth and is presented to the Lieutenant Governor in an administrative year, whom has the highest standing in division rating based on the criteria established by the District. The winner receives a personal plaque.

GLEN BAGNELL AWARD

Past International President Glen Bagnell established the “Glen Bagnell” award to recognize a Lt. Gov. with the growth in the most Clubs, providing it occurs in at least 50% of their clubs. So it is for the greatest percentage of clubs with growth and not the greatest number of new members within a Division. The only restriction is if the Lt. Gov. has 8 or fewer club they must have growth in at least 4 clubs. The winner receives a Mel Osborne Medal.

This Award can be renamed Division Growth Award, as Glen has stated that he would prefer to not have this award named after him,

“COUP DE CHAPEAU” AWARD

This award was established by Past Gov. Pierre Laliberté, selected by the IP Governor, this award is presented to a District Committee Chairperson based on his or her outstanding work and contribution to the District. The winner receives an engraved personal plaque.

AWARDS AT DIVISION LEVEL

FRED MCALLISTER AWARD

This award is presented to an individual, who in the opinion of the District Achievement Committee, has performed the most outstanding service to his/her local community through Kiwanis. The clubs makes recommendations for this award. The winner receives an engraved personal plaque in the shape of a rose bowl.

INTERCLUB AWARD

This Award is based on the Interclub Activity during the year, as reported to the District Achievement Committee. Judging is done by the District Achievement Committee. The winning rclub receives a banner patch in the shape of a shield.

GODFREY DYER MARKETING KIWANIS AWARD

This award is given to recognize club contributions to Marketing, Publicity & Promotion of Kiwanis to the community. Clubs submit material.

This award should be promoted better. Material should be provided to the DST , the Govenor , the District Growth Chair and Divsion LG on what is received and approved. This should be a Division Award. This can be presented by the Governor when attending the Division or Lt. Governor at a Division council Meeting.

GOVERNOR’S GOLD MEDAL AWARD

Initiated by DG Trevor Dunn, this award goes to the club with the highest average points for the club’s Quarterly Reports for the 2006-2007 year.

As from 1 October this year we will be making monthly reports and the LG ribbon will be given out quarterly. This award can be given out at the Division Council Meeting by the Lt. Governor.

RALPH TAYLOR MEMORIAL GONG

Established in memory of an inspiring leader in Northern Ontario, this award is presented to the club that issued the best Weekly Bulletin, according to the criteria set out by the Club Bulletin Contest. The Club Bulletin Judge selects the club based on the submissions by the Clubs. The club receives a banner patch and their name is engraved on this award. With a low percentage of the Kiwanis Clubs having a weekly/biweekly Bulletin, it is recommended this become a Division presentation. It can be presented by the Governor when attending the Division or the Lt. Governor at a Division Council Meeting.

LAURENT GIROUARD TROPHY

This trophy was established by Past Governor Laurent Girouard and is presented to the runner-up in the Club Bulletin Contest for 2007-2008. The Club receives a banner patch and their name is engraved on the District Award.

With a low percentage of the Kiwanis Clubs having a weekly/biweekly Bulletin, it is recommended this become a Division presentation. It can be presented by the Governor when attending the Division or the Lt. Governor at a Division Council Meeting.

AWARD OF MERIT

This trophy is provided by Past Governor Hedley Ivany, for the Club Secretary who has been judged, according to the criteria of the District, to be the outstanding « Unsung Hero ». The clubs makes recommendations for this award to the Achievement Committee. The winner's name is engraved on the District Award and he or she receives both a personal plaque and a banner patch showing a quill and pen.

This is an Award that sees a very small number of recommendations from clubs. It should be marketed better by each Division Lt. Governor and we recommend it be a Division presentation by the Governor when attending the Division or the Lt. Governor at a Division Council Meeting.

HENRY ELLIOTT MEMORIAL GONG

This is the highest award a club can achieve. It is based on the Annual Club Report submitted on the Club's activities. Judging is done by the District Achievement Committee. The Winner receives a banner patch in the shape of a gong and the club's name is engraved on the gong.

This Award should be a Division presentation. It could be presented by the Governor while attending the Division or by the Lt. Governor at a Division Council Meeting.

AWARDS TO BE DISCONTINUED

KIWANIS INTERNATIONAL FOUNDATION AWARD

This is for the highest per capita giving in the Foundation's Annual Club Gift Campaign. This award has no meaning as there are few who qualify as they contribute through the KFC. Has no value unless criteria is changed.

FRANK SUMMERHAYES AWARD

This award was established by Past Gov. Frank Summerhayes and is presented to the Lt. Gov. who has in the opinion of the Past Governor and the Achievement Committee has produced the best Lt. Gov. Bulletin. For 2006-2007, the winner has his or her name engraved on the District Award and receives an engraved personal plaque.

This Award is not as relevant as it was in the past and we have a very limited number of Lt. Governor Bulletins being prepared. We recommend this be discontinued.
