In recognition of the services being provided by Kiwanis Advisors, effective Administrative Year 2008/2009, we establish the **“Kiwanis Service Leadership Program, Outstanding Kiwanis Advisor Award.”**

This award will be given to the Kiwanian who as a Kiwanis Advisor, offered the most outstanding support to his/her Kiwanis Club’s Sponsored Service Leadership Programs during the Administrative Year.

The “Kiwanis Service Leadership Program Outstanding Kiwanis Advisor Award” will be awarded on two levels”

1. *“Divisional Kiwanis Service Leadership Programs Outstanding Kiwanis Advisor of the Year Award”*
2. *“Eastern Canada & the Caribbean District, Kiwanis Service Leadership Programs Outstanding Kiwanis Advisor of the Year Award”*

This contest will be judged based on the following criteria:

1. New Service Leadership Clubs formed
2. Support to Service Leadership Clubs through:
 - SLP Meeting Attendance
 - SLP Project Attendance
 - SLP Convention Support and Attendance
 - SLP Club Training
 - SLP dues payment
 - Support to District Administrators
 - Obvious improvement to Service Leadership Programs through K Advisor’s guidance

PROCEDURE AND GUIDELINES

1. By the end of each administrative year, individual clubs will nominate a Service Leadership Program Kiwanis Advisor as entrant for the “Divisional Service Leadership Program Outstanding Kiwanis Advisor of the Year Award.” The Kiwanis Club will outline the Kiwanian’s service and achievements as it relates to Service Leadership Programs for the administrative year based on the set criteria. The Lt. Governor or assignee(s) will select and award a “Divisional Service Leadership Programs Outstanding Kiwanis Advisor of the Year”
2. This award will take the form of a certificate depicting Service Leadership Programs.
3. The award will be presented at the first Divisional Council Meeting following the relevant administrative year. Presentation to be made by the Immediate Past Lt. Governor.
4. Each division will forward the information on the divisional winner to the District’s Awards and Achievement Committee by January 31 for selection of the District Winner.
5. The district award will be presented at the next district convention by the Immediate Past Governor.
