## **Eastern Canada and Caribbean Circle K District- January, 2010**

### **Service**

The District continues to perform satisfactorily and the service hours tally to date is approximately 15,000 and reporting by the clubs has improved during this administrative year.

### **District Convention**

The 2010 District Convention is being actively planned and this will take place on March 12 - 14 2010 at the Runaway Heart Hotel in Runaway Bay, Jamaica. Registration has started to come in but this very slow at this time.

### **CK International Convention**

The International Convention, August 5 – 9 2009, Birmingham, Alabama was attended by a delegation of 4 from the District including the Governor.

### **Membership and Dues**

The total number of listed clubs in the District is 39 including active, retained and inactive clubs. These include 29 in the Caribbean and 10 in Eastern Canada. Of these only 12 have paid any dues and only seven have paid District dues to date. It is expected that the situation will improve as the February 1 date approaches but there is a growing trend for clubs to pay International dues to be on the Register and avoid paying dues to the District. Correspondence will be sent to the International Office shortly to address this situation. However, the Sponsoring Kiwanis Clubs need to pay much more attention to their clubs' financial obligation.

Membership count to date as recorded is 316 International and 183 District.

**Two new clubs have joined the District : The UWI St. Augustine Campus; and The UWI Mona Western Jamaica Campus.** Congratulations to the Kiwanis Club of St. Augustine and The Kiwanis Club of Montego Bay. In addition there are 3 inactive clubs in Jamaica which are being re-organised at this time.

## **Circle K Activities**

Circle K members have involved in varying and meaningful activities in their core service and leadership focus. They have participated in the Kiwanis Family activities during November and Annual District Leadership Training Conference in October was attended by over 160 CKers.

## **Administrative Activities**

The Administrator has attended The Circle K International Convention in August 2009 and has been involved in all District Board Meetings, Training Conferences, a number of Club installations, the Charter Presentation for the UWI Western Campus Club as well the Kiwanis Family activities etc. In addition, arrangements are proceeding for his participation in the Charter Ceremony for the newly formed St. Augustine Club. In addition, he is actively involved in the planning of the District Convention.
