TO ALL CLUBS IN E.C.& C.

Following the Sarnia Convention, the Board of Trustees decided to impose a moratorium on the awarding of future convention sites after 2009.

At its meeting in Chicoutimi, the Board decided to lift the moratorium and Governor Dr. John Button informed the District Convention Committee that it can now ask clubs to submit their bid should they wish to host a District Convention starting in 2010.

The District Convention Committee will continue to award future District Conventions to the best bid received, after ensuring that they meet all of the criteria established by the District.

The application is on the District web site along with the basic convention criteria for hosting a convention. All applications must be received at District office by July 15th, 2006.

As a gentle reminder all hotel/convention hall/congress centre contracts must be approved and signed by the District Secretary/Treasurer.

As per policy F115 approved January 24, 2003 by the Board of Trustees, 25% of the net profits shall be returned to the host club or clubs, after the audited reports are received, within the prescribed time period.

We strongly recommend you read the convention guidebook and work with the District Convention Committee representatives while organizing the District convention.
