

Eastern Canada and the Caribbean District Distinguished Program 2022-2023

To achieve **Distinguished Club Status**, clubs must score at least 25 points in each of the 5 following categories.

1. Membership and Engagement

Club finished the year with a minimum net growth of 2 (two) members as certified by October 10th, 2023 - **25 points.**

OR

Chartered a minimum of 1 (one) new Adult Kiwanis Club - 25 Points

Note: Only 1 sponsoring club may claim points for chartering a club. Points in this category cannot be shared

2. Community Impact

A Kiwanis Club that sponsored a Service Leadership Program (SLP) Club, met all the required sponsorship responsibilities including its financial obligations and verified support provided by a minimum of one Kiwanis Club Advisor **– 25 points**

OR

Chartered one SLP Club by September 30, 2023 **– 25 points** NOTE: only clubs with no existing SLP clubs are eligible.

Note: Only 1 sponsoring club may claim points for chartering a club. Points in this category cannot be shared

OR

Delivered a minimum of 1 (one) new service project for children that involves at least 50% of the club's membership. A report must be attached to the Distinguished Club application form and submitted in October 2023 – 25 Points

3. Kiwanis Image

The Club entered a Signature Project in the District Signature Project Contest - 25 Points

4. Financial Viability

All Dues invoiced were received by Kiwanis International by December 31, 2022. (Payment must appear on the Kiwanis International's January 2023 report.) – **25 Points**

5. Leadership and Education

The five key members of the Club's Incoming Club Leadership Team for the 2023-2024 administrative year completed Club Leadership Education Training in 2023 – President, President-elect, Secretary, Treasurer and Membership Chair. – **25 Points**

Kiwanis International Pinnacle Award

This award is given by Kiwanis International who will determine a club's eligibility and success.

PINNACLE CLUBS

GROWTH (Must accomplish two of three)

- Minimum of 10% net increase in membership over the prior year's membership, as certified by October 10, 2023.
- Sponsorship of a new Kiwanis club during the year.
- Participation in the Two For Two program all 12 months of the year, as reported in the club's official monthly reports.

SERVICE (Must accomplish two of three)

- Minimum required increase in overall giving to the Kiwanis Children's Fund (as determined by the Children's Fund).
- Participation in the Kiwanis Signature Project Contest during the administrative year.
- Increase in the number of specific or overall Service Leadership Programs clubs in good standing during the previous administrative year.
